Dear Residents/Tenants,

CRIME PREVENTION ADVISORY – THEFT IN DWELLING

Several cases of **Theft in Dwelling** were reported in Simei housing estates recently. Valuables such as handphones, wallets, cash and laptops were reported stolen. Valuables were placed near to unsecured windows situated along the common corridor.

2. It is important that you remain vigilant to prevent yourself from becoming the next victim of crime. You can prevent your personal belongings from being stolen by adopting the following crime prevention measures:

- a) If you are sharing the same room with other tenants, you should not leave your valuables unattended even if these tenants are known to you;
- b) Invest in a quality safe to store your personal belongings and valuables;
- c) Refrain from keeping large amount of cash in your room;
- d) Do not place any valuables near to the windows situated along the common corridor and keep them away from the view of passers-by; and
- e) Lock all the doors and windows when leaving home unattended, even if it is for a short while;

3. If you are keen to play a part in making your estate a safer place to live in, you can participate in the Citizens-On-Patrol (COP) initiative.
